#### **EVALUATION OF THE 2025 SENIOR ENTREPRENEURS MENTORING PROGRAMME**

#### **PRIMETIME**

This is the second cohort of the **PRIMETIME** programme. The first, held in 2024, ran for twelve months, and supported 19 participants aged 50 and over. In 2025, the programme was delivered over six months, supporting 17 individuals in the same age group. Drawing on lessons from the initial cohort where we offered monthly workshops complemented by optional mentoring, we refined the approach to focus on six months of mentoring, with participants also gaining access to Chamber workshops and training opportunities.

The overall aim of the programme was to

Empower and support entrepreneurs aged 50 and above who are looking to start or scale their business ventures.

By the end of the programme participants were expected to

- **Clarified their intentions** Determined whether starting a business was truly the right path for them.
- **Built capability** Gained the personal confidence and foundational business skills necessary to operate a successful venture.
- **Created a clear plan** Developed a practical and achievable plan to guide the next steps in bringing their business idea to life.
- Appreciated the value of mentorship Understood the importance of having a mentor and been encouraged to continue a mentor relationship beyond the programme.

#### **Programme**

The programme comprised of:

- Personal mentoring tailored to their business goals.
- Professional development through the Nelson Tasman Chamber of Commerce (NTCC) training programmes.
- Regular networking opportunities at the Chamber's monthly Business After 5 events.
- Complimentary Chamber of Commerce membership for the duration of the programme.

## **Project Delivery**

Participants made an online application. Selection included an interview with the Programme Coordinator. Each participant also worked with the Programme Coordinator as a mentor and had access to a range of workshops and networking events through the NTCC.


Ten participants (60%) completed the questionnaire at the end of the programme








#### What is your current employment status?




# Do you have previous experience in running or managing a business?


## Was your business idea in mind when you started the program?

## **Summary and Recommendations**

With 17 participants aged 50 and over, the programme achieved its core aims: to help individuals clarify their entrepreneurial intentions, develop foundational business skills, and build practical business plans.

Feedback from the post-programme survey, completed by 60% of participants, confirms the value of the programme's tailored mentoring model and the importance of peer and professional networks in supporting older entrepreneurs. The demographics reveal strong engagement from women and NZ European participants, particularly in the 50–54 age range, with scope to increase participation from a wider age and ethnic demographic in future cohorts.

#### Key strengths of the programme included:

- Personalised mentoring aligned with each participant's business goals
- Access to Chamber training and events that enhanced professional confidence
- The opportunity to test ideas in a safe and supportive environment

#### **Recommendations for future iterations:**

- 1. **Extend diversity outreach** to better engage Māori, Pacific Peoples, and other underrepresented communities.
- 2. **Enhance marketing** to reach a broader spectrum of participants across the 55+ age range.
- 3. **Maintain the six-month structure** but consider optional extensions or alumni mentoring circles.
- 4. **Continue partnerships** with the Office of the Seniors, Nelson City Council and Tasman District Council to ensure access to relevant resources and support.

Overall, the 2025 PRIMETIME cohort has reaffirmed the value of targeted mentoring and capability-building for older entrepreneurs in the region, contributing positively to local innovation and economic development.
